**RECONITION FOR A JOB WELL DONE- KMCLP Pipeline crew**

Victoria, BC. – On January 13, 2004, the KMCLP Pipeline crews were presented with certificates of outstanding performance by the founder of the company, Dennis Alphonse and the General Manager of KMCLP, Dana Francis.

Over the month of December 2003, the KMCLP Pipeline Crews, based in Victoria, completed 118 services for Terasen Gas Vancouver Island.

“The crews really pulled through,” says GM Dana Francis. “Many of the guys worked straight through the holidays without a day off to see the jobs get done.”

In October 2003, Cowichan Tribes signed a Memorandum of Understanding with Terasen Gas Vancouver Island to reinforce the working partnership. KMCLP pipeline division employs up to four crews that construct service and mainline natural gas pipeline for Terasen Gas in the Greater Victoria area servicing over 13 municipalities.

“The Exceptional Service Award is presented to employees that have demonstrated service to KMCLP that is above and beyond the call of duty. It is public recognition of the employees’ efforts that when called upon to place their company, project and job above everything else, they have done so.”

The pipeline division of the Khowutzun Mustimuhw Contractors (KMC), wholly-owned and operated by the Cowichan Tribes has been installing distribution mains and services for Terasen Gas in the greater Victoria area for the last 8 years. KMC has also completed work for Terasen Gas elsewhere on Vancouver Island, the Sunshine Coast and the Resort Municipality of Whistler.
